PLANT NAME	CHARACTERISTICS	GROWING CONDITIONS	PICTURE
BROMELIAD	A relative of the pineapple plant, this plant may have spines along the edges of its leaves, so keep this in mind when placing close to a walk or path. It's a good idea to wear gloves when handling. A Bromeliad should not be placed where other plants overshadow it. There are a variety of species and flowers.	BRIGHT SHADE/PARTIAL SUN	
CARISSA MACROCARPA	Also known as Natal Plum. This is an easy to grow spiny evergreen, perennial shrub with dense leathery green leaves, fragrant white flowers and showy edible red fruits.	SUN/PARTIAL SHADE	
CHRYSOBALANUS	Chrysobalanus icaco, also known as the cocoplum, is native to Florida and described as a low shrub or bushy tree. It has small white flowers and produces edible fruit.	SUN/PARTIAL SHADE

CORDYLINES	The Cordyline plants have various Ti plant varieties, some with maroon and green leaves, some have hot pink tips, and some with variegated leaves. The Red Sister Ti plant, in particular, has colorful foliage with burgundy to pinkish leaves.	SUN/PARTIAL SHADE	
CROTON	Croton are members of the <i>Euphorbiaceae</i> family of plants, which makes them relatives of the poinsettia and the cast iron plant. The croton is an easy-to-grow plant known for its variegated foliage covered in green, scarlet, orange, and yellow splotches.	FULL SUN	
DWARF OYSTER	Dwarf oyster plant is a popular groundcover for its low height and unique coloration of green leaves backed with purple. It's ideal under small palms like the pygmy date palm, or it can be used as border plants for beds.	PARTIAL SUN OR PARTIAL SHADE

GAMOLEPIS	Also known as the African Bush Daisy, this plant is a shrubby evergreen with bright yellow daisy flowers. Flowering is heaviest during the cool months of the year.	FULL SUN	
IXORA	The plant has glossy leathery leaves that are oval shaped and stiff. The plant is similar in appearance to and related to the gardenia. Blooms are clusters of four petaled florets which can last four to six weeks on the stem. Flowers are most prolific in summer but can also appear at other times of the year.	SUN/PARTIAL SHADE	
JASMINE	Jasmine Wax is a tropical evergreen shrub. This plant produces shiny, green leaves and wonderfully fragrant white star-like flowers that bloom year round with very abundant blooms in late spring and early summer.	SUN/PARTIAL SHADE

LIRIOPE	The Liriope genus includes a small number of grass-like flowering perennial plants known as creeping liriope or monkey grass. Liriope plants make tough, drought-tolerant ground covers. Even though liriope looks like grass, it's an herbaceous flowering perennial plant in the asparagus family.	SUN OR SHADE	
PLUMBAGO	The plumbago plant (<i>Plumbago auriculata</i>), also known as the Cape plumbago or sky flower, is actually a shrub. Plumbago plants are sprawling shrubs with branches that resemble vines. It is prized for the profusion of blue phlox-like flowers it produces for extended periods of time.	SUN/PARTIAL SHADE	
STRELITIZIA	Bird-of-paradise or crane flower is a native of South Africa and is closely related to the banana. The herbaceous plant derives its common names from the unique flower it bears, which resembles a brightly colored bird in flight	SUN/PARTIAL SHADE

WHITE GARDENIA	Attractive evergreen shrub or small tree with glossy foliage. Highly scented, creamy-white flowers are particularly fragrant at night. An ideal garden accent or hedge for mild winter gardens.	FILTERED SUN
